Street Whyze Project

Chasetown Community School pupils were privileged to be able to welcome Danny Mondesir to their school to inform the pupils of all ages of the impact that knife crime can have on communities.

The engagement from the pupils was amazing and they were very keen to ask a variety of serious questions that Danny was all too happy to answer.

Danny started the workshops with his background, which the pupils found very interesting, as he has a wealth of experience and knowledge of how to keep both himself and others safe through making the correct choices in his young adult life that has led to the Street Whyze Project.

The pupils were then exposed to the reality of why people carry knives, the influence of social media and explained what is meant by joint enterprising. The pupils gained a deeper understanding of the meaning with a short role play example, which was very powerful as the pupils could really relate to the situation.
